This is for both residential and commercial projects.

An accredited HomeGuard® operator is an individual that holds the appropriate licensing, site safety particulars, and the correct indemnity insurance for the state they are working within and has a current HomeGuard® Accreditation Certificate.

Accredited HomeGuard Installer Responsibilities:

- The installation of the HomeGuard® Precision Termite Management system is the sole responsibility of the HomeGuard® accredited pest professional.
- Any and all communication for the scope of work is to be managed by the installer; all stake holders should be considered; architect, builder, plumber, carpenter etc.
- Any and all communications with respect to warranty particulars are to be communicated by the installer to all stake holders; in most cases home owners, building owners or developers etc.
- All questions surrounding the warranty are to be managed by the installing company.

FMC Australasia has the responsibility to:

- Supply a fit-for-purpose product to their respective supply channel.
- Provide installation accreditation.
- FMC Australasia is not required to conduct onsite inspections of HomeGuard® Installations; this responsibility stays with the installer – Residential & Commercial
